

OUR 12-POINT VULNERABILITY INDICATOR

Our 12-point vulnerability indicator was developed from hundreds of intake interviews conducted with survivors of sex trafficking across Nigeria. It is utilized as an anecdotal guide in determining the extent to which pre-trafficking beneficiaries are susceptible to becoming trafficked. We have found that women identifying 6 or more indicators are vulnerable to being recruited and/or trafficked within a year if interventions are not timely effected. - 1. Woman/girl aged 15-35
- 2. Orphaned or from a single parent home
- 3. Usually eldest sibling
- 4. Minimal to no education or employable skill
- 5. Living in abject poverty
- 6. Parents illiterate or poorly educated
- 7. Is unemployed or underemployed
- 8. Pressure from family and peers
- (particularly mother) to travel abroad
- 9. Has sibling or peer that is already abroad
- 10. Has some social media access
- 11. Maintains perverted/misguided ambition (mindset)
- or low self worth/esteem that embraces/potentially
- embraces prostitution as a viable alternative to poverty
- 12. Prior history of child abuse or rape
